1 New Features

The version 5.2.0 release of Site Manager for Geocortex IMF contains the following new features. Note that some minor new features may have been developed and are not documented here.

General	
Allow application configuration to specify separate directories for session and upload.	Site Manager versions prior to 5.2.0 allow the user to specify an "output" directory that affects the values of the session-directory and upload-directory properties in imf.properties as well as the pdf-directory and pdf-url. Version 5.2.0 provides separate fields for session and upload for users that want to make these directories "non-web" directories (for example, in WEB-INF).
Faster site loading times.	Site Manager loads sites for configuration much more efficiently with version 5.2.0. This most directly affects sites with large layer configuration files.
Local help documents.	IMF 5.2.0 now includes help content. Site Manager will first look in the IMF application when retrieving help content, and will only look to the MoxiMedia web site when the local help content cannot be found.
IMF 5.2.0 compatibility.	Site Manager now is compatible with versions of IMF from version 5.0.008 up to 5.2.0.

2 Resolved Defects

The version 5.2.0 release of Site Manager for Geocortex IMF resolves the following defects. Note that some minor defects may have been resolved and are not documented here.

General	
Previewing site in ServletExec.	ServletExec session IDs sometimes contain characters which are invalid for use in a URL. Site Manager 5.2.0 now correctly escapes these characters so that the preview option works correctly.
Creating new site in ServletExec.	When creating a new site with ServletExec, it says "site name required" even though one was specified, and it pushes you back to create site form.
The Link to IMF from editing the Default Site is broken.	When editing the default site, if the user selects the root "IMF" from the navigation tree, an error occurs.
Copying sites with security enabled causes error.	When using the copy function on a site with security, an error is generated which results in the target site's entry in security.xml being removed as well as no new entry being placed for the destination site.

Sql Connections	
Sql Connections component does not close database connections.	Site Manager does not close the connection to the database in the "Sql Connections" section. For a MS Access db, this means the .ldb (lock) file for Access is not deleted.

Sql Reports	
SQL Report form doesn't clear after submission.	After creating a Sql Report, when attempting to add another one on a different layer, the form values are listing the database fields for the previous layer.

Documentation	
Quick Search documentation.	Invalid links and out of date images have been replaced with updated configuration instructions for Quick Search.
